CODE OF CONDUCT

In order that the tour is an enjoyable and safe experience for all participants a very high standard of behaviour is expected from every member of the group.

Members of the group will:

- be good ambassadors for the Bradford Youth Orchestra in particular and the United Kingdom in general
- be courteous to all other members of the group and to any other third party
- take reasonable care of property and accommodation
- report any damage or incident immediately to the group leader or other member of staff
- comply with instructions given by any person in authority
- observe local customs and traditions

Members of the group will not:

- enter the bedroom of members of the opposite sex unless they are a legally married couple
- consume any beverage or food in the bedrooms
- possess or use any banned substances or solvents
- consume alcohol
- smoke or do anything which would constitute a fire hazard in the bedroom
- play musical instruments except at concert and rehearsal venues and in accommodation authorised by a member of staff

Sanctions will be imposed on any individual who, in the opinion of the group leader and after due consultation with other members of staff, causes a breach of this code of conduct. These will range from closer supervision to a premature return to England at the student's expense. All staff will be sensitive to the appropriate degree of inquiry following an incident, being mindful of the age and maturity of the individual concerned.

All staff will do their utmost to ensure the safety and well being of all members of the group but each individual must also take responsibility for their own safety and other members of the group. Helping each other will help to ensure an incident free tour.
